Innovation-Technology (In-Tech) Program

2024 HIGHLIGHTS

The In-Tech Program supports innovative, technology-based small businesses with business coaching services, training, and funding assistance, with a unique focus on the federal Small Business Innovation & Research (SBIR) and Small Business Technology Transfer (STTR) non-dilutive seed fund program.

The In-Tech Program also manages the **WV Entrepreneurship & Innovation Investment (EII) Fund**, which provides state matching funds for SBIR and STTR awardees.

• Phase 0 Awards: 17 \$42,500

Phase I Awards: 9 \$368.750 (leveraged \$2,151,929 of federal SBIR/STTR funds received)
 Phase II Awards: 3 \$270,000 (leveraged \$3,872,247 of federal SBIR/STTR funds received)

IN-TECH SUCCESS STORY

This program has assisted some of West Virginia's most innovative and inspiring entrepreneurs and served as a catalyst for growth. Learn how O-Analytics won a \$1.25M Phase II STTR award from the Department of Defense.

O ANALYTICS INCORPORATED - FAIRMONT, WV

O Analytics is a premier space object characterization company offering physics-based and Al/ML solutions for surveillance, intelligence gathering, space domain awareness, satellite custody management, space traffic management, rendezvous proximity operations, debris detection and collision avoidance. Essentially, they provide insight into what objects are present in space, what they are doing, and what they are likely to do next, at any point in time.

The company won their first SBIR award from the Department of Defense on their first try in March 2020. Since then, they have won five additional DoD SBIR/STTR awards. In March 2024 the In-Tech Program assisted the client in receiving funds from the State's Entrepreneurship & Innovation Investment (EII) Fund as a match for a Phase II STTR award of \$1.25M from the DoD/Air Force for Super-Resolved Object Characterization for Low Earth Orbit (SROC LEO). A Phase 0 grant plus matching funds of were issued to the client in July 2024 for another Phase I SBIR proposal which was submitted and awarded. The In-Tech Program has also assisted with general business coaching services.

2024 HIGHLIGHTS

West Virginia BusinessLink is West Virginia's premier hub for connecting entrepreneurs and small businesses with the resources they need to succeed. By fostering meaningful connections and providing targeted support, the platform continues to play a vital role in driving economic growth statewide.

In 2024, WV BusinessLink achieved significant milestones:

- 14,000 website users accessed the platform.
- 361 total engagements facilitated meaningful connections.
- 88 referrals linked businesses to critical resources.
- **2,733 total searches** were conducted by users, with more than 161,739 resource partner search impressions.

Our platform now features a robust network of **175 resource partners** from across West Virginia, ensuring comprehensive support for businesses at every stage.
